

Applications are invited from willing retired Vigilance/ Police Officers in the rank of Inspector of Police and above having at least 10 years or more experience in investigation /prosecution matters for engagement as "Prosecution Liaison Officer" in the Vigilance Organisation at **Balasore, Sambalpur, Sundargarh, Koraput (Jeypore), Cuttack, Bhubaneswar and Berhampur** on contractual basis initially for a period of one year, which may be extended or curtailed basing on their performance and upon approval of Government, but not beyond the age of 65 years in any case as envisaged in GA Department Resolution No.23750 dt. 27.08.2014. The applicants must have good service record, physically fit and not above the age of 63 years (as on the closing date of the advertisement). The consolidated remuneration for such engagement will be Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) only per month.







ii) I undertake that if number of candidates will be more than requirement for a particular district for which I have submitted option, I have no objection to be engaged in nearby districts.

iii) Further, I undertake that during the re-engagement as PLO in Vigilance, I shall not apply/submit my Bio-data / offer my candidature for my re-engagement in other organisation without due permission of Director, Vigilance. If I do so without permission of Director, Vigilance and join other organisation relinquishing re-engagement from Vigilance, it would be constructed as violation of Govt. Servants' Conduct Rules and action as deemed proper will be taken by the competent authority.

Terms of Reference (TOR) for engagement of Prosecution Liaison Officers on contractual basis in the Vigilance Organisation.

1. Job Description :-

(a) Posts:- **08 (Eight)**

(b) Suitable retired Vigilance/Police Officers in the rank of Inspector of Police and above having 10 years or more experience in investigation/ prosecution matters will be engaged as Prosecution Liaison Officer in the Vigilance Organisation on contractual basis with consolidated remuneration of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) only per month. They may be required to discharge their duties at any of the following places, namely, **Balasore, Sambalpur, Sundargarh, Koraput (Jeypore), Cuttack, Bhubaneswar and Berhampur**. Candidates interested for posting other than the above seven places need not apply.

2. Aims and Objectives :-

- (a) To manage and monitor the day to day work of prosecution of cases and report the same on a daily basis to Divisional SP/ Unit DSP and in important cases to Prosecution Cell of Vigilance Directorate.
- (b) To collect and furnish present address of witnesses in all the year old cases under trial.
- (c) To serve summons to the witnesses in their present address so as to procure their attendance on the dates fixed for trial and ensure return of the summons after their service to the witnesses well before the next date of trial.
- (d) To assist the Special Public Prosecutor in prosecution related matters.
- (e) To ensure attendance of the witnesses and investigating officers by being in constant touch with them.
- (f) To perform such other duties as and when assigned by the competent authority.

3. Eligibility Criteria :-

(a) Retired Vigilance/Police Officers in the rank of Inspector of Police and above (having 10 years or more experience in Investigation/ Prosecution matters) who have retired from Govt. Service on attaining the age of superannuation and not above the age of 63 years as on the closing date of advertisement are eligible to apply.

- (b) Applicants if prematurely or voluntarily retired from Govt. service will not be considered.
- (c) Applicants against whom departmental proceeding or Vigilance or criminal case is contemplated or pending or who has been penalized for misconduct during the period of preceding five years from the date of superannuation/ voluntary retirement or who has been convicted by a Court of Law, will not be considered for engagement.
- (d) Working computer knowledge is desirable.

4. Tenure, Terms and Conditions :-

- (a) The engagement will be made initially for a period of one year which may be extended or curtailed based on performance assessment and further approval of the Government, but not beyond the age of sixty-five (65) years of age in any case.
- (b) Although places of engagement will be given according to their preference as far as practicable, if number of candidates will be more than requirement for a particular district, they will be engaged to nearby districts.
- (c) The retired officer will be engaged on contractual basis with consolidated remuneration of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) only per month.
- (d) They will not be eligible for Dearness Allowance or any other Special Pay or Allowance over and above the consolidated remuneration.
- (e) They will be governed by the provisions of Odisha Government Servants' Conduct Rules, 1957 and will be liable to be proceeded against for their misconduct, omissions and commissions as per the provisions under the Odisha Pension Rules, 1992.
- (f) They will be required to maintain utmost confidentiality and integrity in their conduct.
- (g) This engagement can be terminated at any time by the Director, Vigilance on grounds of unsatisfactory performance or in case of any misconduct, misappropriation, negligence or causing loss to Government or any breach of conduct by the engaged officer or indictment in a Court of Law, by giving 1(one) month notice. Such termination of his/her engagement may further debar him/her from further engagement in the Department. Conversely, if any engaged Prosecution Liaison Officer desires to resign, he/she shall do so by giving 1(one) month's written notice to the Director, Vigilance.

(h) Since this process of selection and engagement is being made with expenditure of Govt. funds in advertisement and utilization of official time, relinquishment by a contractual engagee whimsically before expiry of his tenure of one year will be loss of Govt. fund as well as loss of official business held for this purpose. Hence, during the re-engagement as PLO in Vigilance, one cannot apply/submit his Bio-data / offer his candidature for his re-engagement in other organisation without due permission of Director, Vigilance. If one does so without permission of Director, Vigilance and joins other organisation relinquishing re-engagement from Vigilance, it would be construed as violation of Govt. Servants' Conduct Rules.

5. Selection Process :-

The selection for the required posts will be made by a Selection Committee as decided by the Director, Vigilance.
